

# Special Educational Needs Information

## Supporting children when changing schools

We aim to make times of transition as easy as possible for the children in our school.

#### When starting at our school we can offer:

- A meeting with the child and their parents to talk about their needs and answer any questions about our school
- Communicate with staff at the child's previous school or setting
- Provide the child with a transition book that has photographs of the key staff and areas around school, if necessary
- Read reports from people who have worked with the child
- Arrange visits to our school so the child gets to see it before they start properly
- Give any adults working with the child a one-page profile describing the things that help to support them in school

### When moving to a new year group we:

- Introduce the child to their new teacher
- Provide the child with an updated transition book that has photographs of the key staff and areas around school to look at during the school holidays, if necessary.
- Talk to the child and their family so we can answer any questions they may have about the new year group.
- Give any adults working with the child a one-page profile describing the things that help to support them in school

#### When moving to a new school we:

- Invite teachers from the new school to the SEN Plan/Annual Review meting
- Talk to key staff (SENCo/Head of Year) at the new school about things

that help the child to learn well and be happy at school

- Arrange extra visits to the new school with a member of staff from our school if that is what the child wants/needs
- Talk to the child and their family so we can answer any questions they may have about the new school
